"The Tabley House Family at War by Victoria Astridge" -Tabley House near Knutsford was home to the Leicester family for over 200 years. Looking at family letters and documents that were recently discovered in the house, Victoria has pieced together their personal reflections and experiences during the Second World War. This includes the family's son-in-law, Lt. General Sir Oliver Leese, whose letters discuss his service during some of the major turning points of the war.

"The Northwich Contribution to Winning World War Two by Clive Brookes" - Northwich and the surrounding villages played a vital and largely unrecognised or forgotten role in the war years from 1939-1945. Many local industries that had previously grown up to serve the local salt and chemical industries now had to support the national war economy. This included a wide range of community and industrial commitment from shipyards on the Weaver to factories turning out tank parts and tank transporters and constructing the important pier heads of the famous Mulberry Harbours. Clive will talk about this and more.

"Stretton Water Mill by Kate Harland" - Stretton Water Mill is a 14th century corn mill near Tilston. Kate has been a miller at Stretton since 2004 and now manages the building as part of West Cheshire Museums.
